## DIRECTIONS to DCCC STEM Complex (Marple Campus):

### From points North East:

Take PA Turnpike I-276 West to I-476 interchange. Then follow directions from points North.

### From points North:

Take I-476 South to Exit 9 (Broomall). Turn RIGHT onto W Chester Pike / PA-3 West for 2.2 miles. Turn LEFT onto N Line Road which becomes Media Line Road. DCCC Campus entrance is 1.5 miles on LEFT. Follow campus directions below.

### From Center City Philadelphia:

Take Market Street West. Continue as it becomes West Chester Pike (Route 3) after the 69th Street terminal. Go 7.4 miles to Media Line Road. Make a LEFT onto Media Line Road. Proceed approximately 2 miles. The College is on the LEFT. (Despite the Blue Route, this is still the shortest and most direct route.)

### From points South:

Take I-476 to Exit 5 (Lima/Springfield). Turn LEFT onto US-1 West for 1.5 miles. Take Exit for PA-252, turn RIGHT onto PA-252 N / N. Providence Road. After 0.4 miles bear right to continue on PA-252 N. Drive 1.8 miles (passing first entrance to DCCC), turn RIGHT onto Media Line Road. DCCC Campus entrance is on RIGHT.

### From points West:

If in Philadelphia Suburbs, take West Chester Pike (Route 3) to PA-252. Turn RIGHT onto PA-252 South. At third traffic light (Media Line Road) turn LEFT. Campus entrance is on your RIGHT.

### On Marple Campus:

Follow winding road to bottom of hill. At bottom, turn RIGHT and look for parking in any non-gated lot. Academic Building is to the right of the courtyard.
