



Call for Nominations - Young Engineer of the Year

Do you know an outstanding young engineer deserving of recognition? Then YOU are invited to submit nominees for the 2022 Young Engineer of the Year (YEOY) Award.

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be 35 years of age or under prior to January 1, 2022 (birth date after January 1, 1986).
- Hold a degree in engineering from a college or university having an accredited curriculum.
- Have demonstrated leadership capabilities and made a recognized contribution to the engineering profession.
- Have participated in and made contributions to technical, charitable, and civic organizations.
- Either reside or have their principal place of business in the Delaware Valley¹ at the time the nomination is submitted.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

- Scholastic [collegiate] achievements
- Engineering professional society activities
- Professional papers authored and/or presented, patents
- Teaching assignments and research and development activities
- Engineering experience & registration / certification [EIT, PE]
- Major professional [work-related] accomplishments
- Additional activities (civic, fraternal, religious, humanitarian)

The YEOY is expected to participate in the following key events of Engineers Week.

- Brief Remarks at the Engineers Week Opening Ceremony on Thursday, February 17, 2022.
- Brief Remarks at the Young Engineers Social the week of February 21, 2022.
